This funding will be used to

- Sourcing and appointing a Literacy and Numeracy Coach to work with the Prep to year 2 cohort of teachers, to explicitly develop capacity of staff in the area of reading to improve student outcomes
- Purchase of Pre Referral Intervention Manual (PRIM) for Administration and Coaching Team
- Renewal of Diagnostic Reading Resources and purchase of online assessment tools Pat V and Pat R

Our strategy will be to

- Source and establish an explicit coaching and mentoring program for beginning teachers within the Prep – Year 2 Cohort, leading to an increase to 80% of students attaining above NMS achievement bands in Year 3 NAPLAN Reading from 69.2% baseline (2013)
- Use PRIM to develop an explicit process of coaching within the school, based on researched and documented best practice consistently across all members of coaching and administration teams
- Renew short, mid and long term data collection tools and assessment analysis processes to drive improvement of student achievement, through detailed and explicit formative assessments. Leading to an increase of 15% of students exceeding Regional Benchmarks in Year 1,2,3 Diagnostic Reading assessments from a 5% baseline (2013)

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employing P-2 Literacy and Numeracy Coach (costed by HR)	\$168,665
• Consistent approaches to coaching and mentoring of beginning teachers	\$1500
• Consistent and transparent formative and diagnostic assessment processes across the school	\$3086
