**Under this agreement for 2018
Doomadgee State School will receive**

\$391,522*

This funding will be used to:

- improve student attendance across high school classes to greater than 'like schools' for 2018
- continue to implement the Doomadgee Way and PBL to develop in domain three of the National Schools Improvement Hierarchy, through supporting students with their behaviours
- improve reading outcomes for all students and develop the capacity of our Indigenous Education Workers to enable improved student support in this area.

Our initiatives include:

Our key priorities are attendance improvements, reading improvements and improving school culture. The initiatives that we will use to meet targets include:

- the implementation of alternative programs for senior students (VET, Horsemanship) to encourage greater participation and attendance
- employing and training Indigenous staff members to work with high school students and provide training in Horsemanship
- continuing to employ a Behaviour Management Team who provide support to all students needing assistance with their behaviour
- increasing the amount of Indigenous Education Workers to two per classroom and provide training in reading instruction, to enable greater support of students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

- Developing the capacity of Indigenous staff in reading instruction to provide support to all students. Reading development is critical for all students and across all levels of schooling. The cost of employing additional IEWs will be **\$120 522**.
- To employ staff needed to provide support with Behaviour Management is **\$180 000**.
- To employ a staff member to work with senior students on alternative programs is **\$61 000**.
- Student participation in alternative programs - **\$30 000**.
